GreenPower growth nears a thousand a day



The second Quarterly Status Report for 2007 has been released. The report covers the period from 1 April to 30 June 2007 and is available on the national GreenPower website at www.greenpower.gov.au

Key achievements for the second quarter of 2007 include:

- Nearly one thousand Australians per day are making the switch to GreenPower;
- Nationally, there are more than 590,000 customers subscribing to GreenPower, an increase of more than 90,000 customers in 3 months; and
- GreenPower sales for the quarter were 286,143 MWh, totalling 522,909 MWh for the first half of 2007
